The main reasons for the formation and development of the current structural crisis of social imbalances are identified: transformation and distortion of information flows; the contradiction between the need and the rejection of industrial production; the gap between the actual utility of things and their estimated value; the priority realization of the values of capitalist formation representatives, protection of positions through latent or explicit discrimination.*
